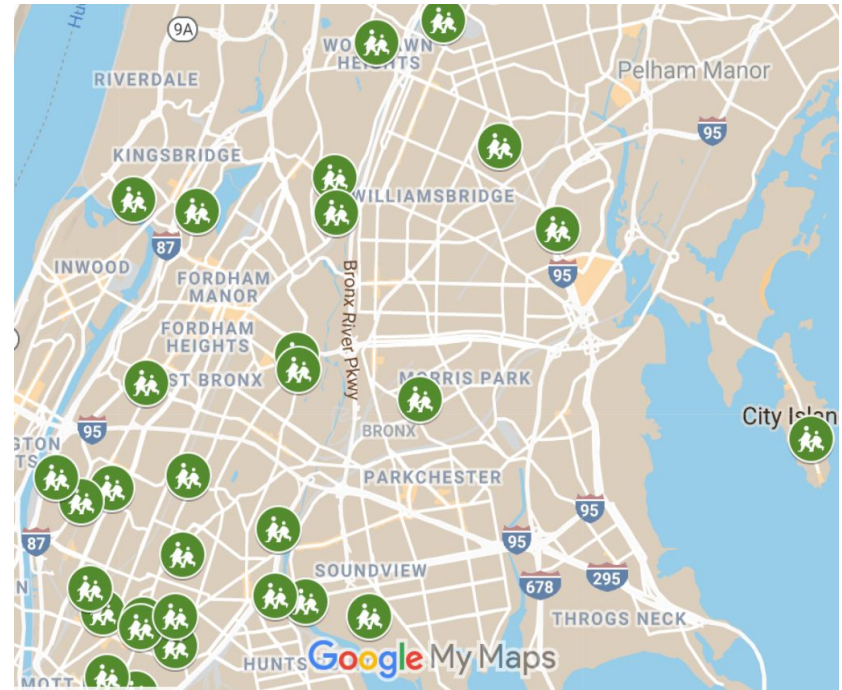
25 years of experience teaching in Bronx public schools

Over 40 different courses delivered to roughly 5K students a year

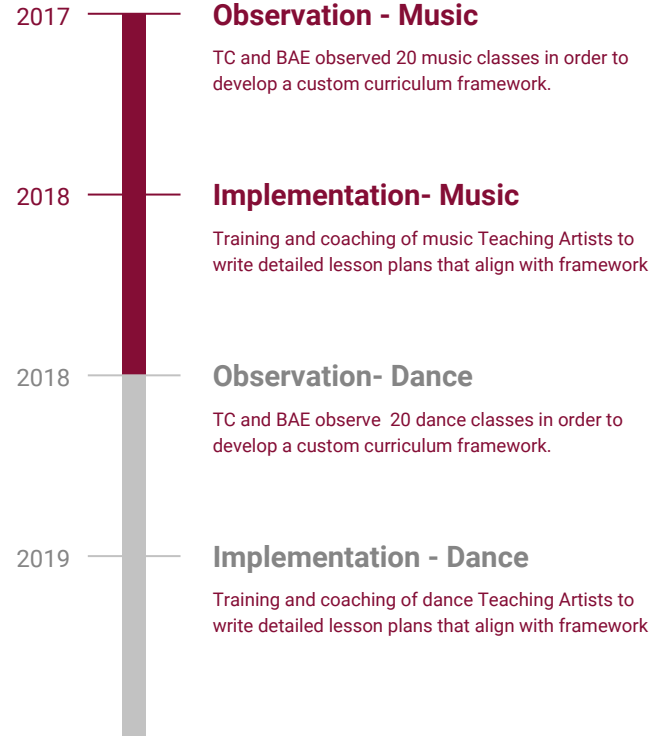
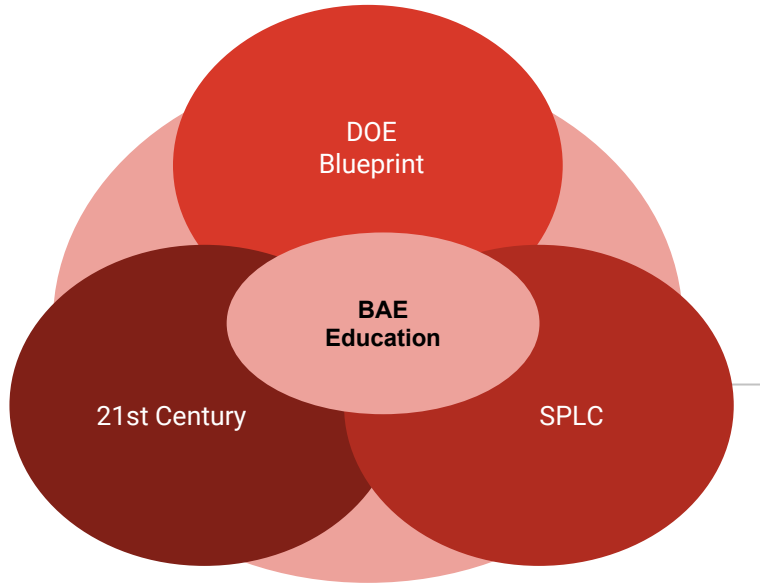

Chorus Curriculum Annual Objectives *(example)*

	NYC Blueprint-Arts Education	SPLC-Social Justice	21st Century-Learning Skills
Kindergarten	Introduction to music, Sing-a-long songs, touching and feeling kinder instruments. Song circle and world music.	Culture sensitivity and age group interests are incorporated into the lesson plan	Students learn to perform the material in front of an audience. In this, they confront their fears and gain confidence from other students
1st Grade	Music literacy through musical notation and rhythmic activity.	Students work on “parts of a whole” or small technique and vocal exercises that tie directly and or indirectly into their course work and performance.	Students learn to identify pitches and low and high notes in relation to the notes they sing or play, thereby making mathematical connections
2nd Grade	Hands on music experience through playing instruments in front of classroom and repeating patterns and rhythms.	Dominant Culture activities and sensitivities intertwined with world music and historic classics in all genres.	To work creatively with other students and solve different non familiar material pertaining to the music at hand.
3rd Grade	Hands on music experience through singing in front of classroom and repeating tones and scales.	Students effectively work with one another on group team projects for writing and composing original music.	To implement innovation through brainstorming and evaluation in order to maximize experience and retain knowledge and information.
4th Grade	Hands on music experience by prepping a lifelong relationship with music not dependent on the instructor.	Developing confidence in their musical ability and creating a space to express pride and confidence through hard work.	Utilize technology and how to use the technology as it pertains to the subject matter.

Arts Curriculum New Strategy

- All 4th and 5th graders will now study violin -- 15 per class, *twice a week*
- Chorus and visual arts will each be offered to all students, K-3, *once a week*
- *Emphasis on semi-annual culminating performances and exhibitions for the Yalow community*
